

Instructions

cutting and attaching the water soluble paper into a tube.

- 1. Take the water-soluble paper and press it evenly against the end of the pipe so that the outside diameter of the pipe is reflected in its contour.
- 2. Take a pair of scissors and cut approx. 30 to 50 mm next to the contour (circular for a pipe).
- 3. Cut from the outside of the cut paper in a star shape up to the contour edge (approx. every 5 10 mm, the larger the diameter, the greater the distance).
- 4. Now insert the cut paper into the end of the tube so that the cut ends of the paper wrap around each other.
- 5. Now fix the folded ends using the water-soluble adhesive tape and stick it in a circle (tightly).

For external use, use steps 1 - 3 and place the ends over the outside of the pipe and now finish with step 5.
